Wool Descriptions: **Light** – Minimal body wool, short neck wool with smooth head, ears & legs. **Medium** – Moderate to long body wool, with minimal to moderate neck wool, smooth to moderate head & leg wool. **Heavy** – Abundant body & neck wool, with minimal to abundant head & leg wool. (i.e. leg wool to at least knee and hock)
