Dear Friends:

Thank you so much for your past support of 4-H and FFA youth at the Fulton County Junior Fair Livestock Sales. Due to changes from coronavirus and a 2020 Fulton County Junior Fair only, I'd like to share the following information with you to better prepare you for your experience at the livestock sales.

In 2020, Fulton County Junior Fair attendance is limited. The Fair Board has decided that this letter will admit you and a guest on sale days (no wristband needed). You may use this letter for one or both days of the livestock sales.

In 2020, the Junior Fair livestock sales will be located in Spangler Arena. Please enter through the East and West doors of Spangler Arena. The **Livestock Sale Committee requests your cooperation in adhering to the guidelines set forth by the Governor's order**, Fulton County Health Department, and Senior Fair Board. Please wear a mask / cloth face covering that covers your nose, mouth, and chin when you are inside Spangler Arena and other buildings, as well as when outside and 6 feet of social distancing cannot be maintained. Please maintain 6 feet of social distancing when you are outside Spangler Arena. Please remember to wash your hands frequently and utilize hand sanitizer stations spread throughout the Fairgrounds. Please adhere to marked traffic flow patterns for pedestrians.

1. **The sale format** is a "Buyer Contribution Sale" to support our 4-H and FFA youth. We have found this format to be clearer for both the youth and the buyers. In the Buyer Contribution Sale the bidding starts at \$0, and the bidding at any time only reflects the contributions of the bidders. The checks that youth receive after the sale will reflect the Buyer Contribution, less commission and promotions, plus the market price of the animal.
2. **Unless prior arrangements have been made with Junior Fair exhibitors and processors, custom kill is not an option in 2020.** Please contact a member of the Livestock Sale Committee if you have any questions.
3. The Livestock Sale Committee will allow buyers to collaborate together to purchase animals; however, **groups will be limited to five (5) bid numbers per animal and each bidder will be limited to two (2) related businesses.**
4. **If you plan to buy for more than one person or business**, please get a separate number for each and use that number when you buy for them. Using only one number for several purchases adds to the confusion and it makes it very difficult to keep our records accurate. Please help us in this way to see that each business gets proper credit for their support and generosity.
5. The Livestock Sale Committee will again be allowing buyers to "add-on" to the seller's donation through the Junior Fair Sale. This is an excellent option for any buyer who desires not to attend an in-person sale. To complete this process, the buyer must complete and "Add On" form enclosed with this letter, available at the Fulton County Fair website (link below), Fulton County Fair Office, Fulton County OSU Extension Office, or the registration area the day-of the livestock sales. Buyers can find a draft sale catalog at <https://fultoncountyfair.com/2020-livestock-sale/> to determine which Junior Fair youth are eligible to receive add ons. There is a \$25.00 minimum amount. The Add On form and

payment of the balance owed is due to the registration area by the close of the Large Animal Sale or can be mailed to F&M Bank (Attn: Livestock Sale, PO Box 216 Archbold OH 43502) postmarked by Friday, September 11. The buyer will not be recognized during the sale, but the exhibitor will be informed of the contributor, and their names will be included in the Thank You ads ran in local newspapers and social media post fair.

New buyers must get their bid number from the registration area before bidding on an animal. If returning buyers have changes in contact information, please report them to the clerks at the registration area.

All checks can be made payable to "Fulton County Junior Fair Livestock Sale." Please settle your account with the sale clerk from F & M Bank in the registration area at your earliest convenience but no later than Thursday afternoon after the Large Animal Sale. If you purchase at both livestock sales on Wednesday and Thursday, you may settle up with the clerk for everything on Thursday.

Thank you for your past support and I hope to see you at the sale again this year.
