We are excited to continue our tradition in offering the round bale decorating contest. This contest is for any organization, group, business, church, youth group and 4-H Clubs.

We will have a maximum of 15 groups to participate. The application below must be submitted by August 1st to Tracy Bentley, Fair Board Director at email: tkb@windstream.net.

The Fulton County Agriculture Society will sponsor a cash award and rosettes for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners. Each organization (not winning 1st, 2nd, 3rd) will receive \$20 toward supplies/materials for their design of the round bale. The organization may start decorating the round bale on Tuesday, August 31st and must be completed by Thursday, September 2nd at 9:00pm. Judging to take place on Friday September 3rd.

Theme this year will be *Country living and Essential workers are Awesome*. The round bale should exhibit something about country living (animal, tractor, etc.) or thank an essential worker (Dr, nurse, frontline worker, etc.) during Co-vid pandemic.

All round bale tear down may start on Thursday, September 9th at 5pm. All decorations must be removed from round bale by close of fair on September 9th.
