



CHECK-IN INSTRUCTIONS

Camping begins Monday prior to Fair week. Campers parking prior to Monday of the Fair week or not removed by Saturday at Noon following the Fair will be charged \$30 per day.

Sunday, August 25 from 9am until 5pm - In the Vendor Office (the old Fair Office) located under the Grandstand

Monday thru Thursday - In the Fair Office during posted times

Please read the following instructions as some of the procedures have changed.

1. The **Registered Renter** of the campsite **MUST** bring your Driver's License / Government issued Photo Id # and Season Ticket when picking up your camping packet. **NO POA will be permitted to sign.**
2. A Registration Form **MUST** be completed and include a phone number where the renter can be reached during the Fair, if necessary. This information will be kept in the Fair Office.
3. A camping permit sticker will be provided when you pick up your camping packet. The sticker must be affixed in a prominent location visible from the roadway side and **MUST** be on at the time of parking your camper.
4. One (1) vehicle permit will be issued per campsite. If parking is not available at your site, then you will need to park in the parking lot(s) outside the fenced area. The permit should be affixed to the drivers' side windshield. If not, the vehicle will not be admitted to the camping area. Any vehicles without a parking permit are subject to be towed.
5. If you have upgraded your camping unit and have outgrown your lot, we may not be able to accommodate your camper.
6. Your camping unit shall be located on the campsite as close as possible to the lot line on the right hand side of your lot as you face your lot number (ex. Lot #1 would be parked as close to the line as possible to Lot #2). This is to ensure maximum distance between units. All camping units must be parked a minimum of 15 feet apart with no connecting awnings between two campers. Only one (1) camping unit per lot. Your camping unit shall not protrude into the roadway. Before unhooking your camper, pull ahead three (3) feet from your ID stake. These are Health Department Rules. **DO NOT UNHOOK FROM CAMPER UNTIL APPROVED BY FAIR CAMPING PERSONNEL.**
